Dear Zoo by Rod Campbell- A tale about a youngster looking for the perfect pet, readers can lift the flaps to see the animals the zoo has sent.

I Love You to the Moon and Back by Amelia Hepworth- A bear and a cub show their love for each other by touching noses, chasing each other, and, of course, hugging and snuggling before bed.

Corduroy by Dan Freeman- a heartwarming story about a little bear and a little girl finding the friend they have always wanted in each other.

<u>Ages 3-5</u>

The Rabbit Listened by Cori Doerrfeld - a deeply moving and unforgettable story sure to soothe heartache of all sizes.

Where the Sidewalk Ends by Shel Silverstein - poetry collections are filled with strange characters and wacky situations sure to keep kids laughing.

Mix it Up! by Herve Tullet -an invitation to mix it up in a dazzling adventure of whimsy and wonder. Tullet prompts plenty of giggles in addition to a profound understanding of colors,

Ages 6-8 - All are series.

Elephant and Piggie - Biggie! #1 by Mo Williams - Gerald is careful. Piggie is not. Piggie cannot help smiling. Gerald can. Gerald worries so that Piggie does not have to. Gerald and Piggie are best friends.

Bird and Squirrel On the Run! by James Burke - graphic novel series about the adventures of two unlikely friends - a squirrel who is scared of everything and a bird who doesn't have a care in the world.

Mercy Watson to the Rescue by Kate DiCamillo- hilariously silly books about Mercy Watson, a pig adopted by an older couple with no children of their own.

Ages 9-11 - All are series.

Dork Diaries: Tales from a Not-So-Fabulous Life by Rachel Renee Russell-The series, written in a diary format, uses drawings, doodles, and comic strips to chronicle the daily life of its initially 14-year-old protagonist, Nikki Maxwell.

Everything, Everything by Nicola Yoon-A young adult romance novel about a girl who falls in love with her new neighbor, who is allergic to the world due to a severe immune deficiency.

Neanderthal Opens the Door to the Universe by Preston Norton-an unforgettable story of finding your place in an imperfect world.
